Title: Love Never Fails

Theme: Perseverance

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 16:13-14 (NIV)

Objective: During this session, the learner will receive practical principles for Christian living to ensure that all actions are motivated by love.

Outreach from Previous Week:

What idols compete for your worship: relationships, comfort, money, success, control or the internet? How do you respond?

Training Text: 1 Corinthians 16:13-14 (NIV)

¹³ Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. ¹⁴ Do everything in love.

Scripture Discussion | 1 Corinthians 16:13

- What does “Be on your guard” mean? Name some things we should be “on guard” against?
 - How does Paul’s final encouragement to “stand firm in the faith” resonate with you, especially today?
 - Explain why being “courageous” and “strong” are such important qualities to have in life.
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Scripture Discussion | 1 Corinthians 16:14

- Paul directs the Corinthians to “do everything in love.” What does this mean to you?
- What connection does love have to the four directives in verse 13?
- How do the two verses in today’s lesson challenge your understanding and practice of Christian fellowship?
